

Welcome and Congratulations to Our New Members!



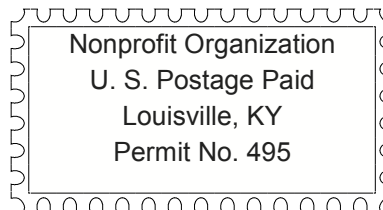
