## Fine Arts Dinner & Wine Tasting

The Fine Arts Committee invites you and a friend to a wine tasting at the outstanding **L&N Wine Bar and Bistro**. On **Monday, January 11 at 7 p.m.**, we will dine on a delicious three course meal, each course being paired with a different wine. During the meal, co-owner Len Stevens will give a brief lesson in tasting wine along with a short history of the wines we are drinking that night.



Our meal will begin with a salad of mixed greens, blue cheese, pear slices, and candied walnuts, all topped with a lavender honey champagne vinaigrette coupled with a **Chenin Blanc** by Ken Forrester from South Africa, vintage 2007. Our Main Course will be the **L&N Pasta Caprese**: Papardelle pasta tossed with prosciutto, basil, house made mozzarella & tomato butter sauce. (This can be made vegetarian upon request.) The pasta will be served with a Norman **Pinot Grigio** from Santa Barbara, vintage 2006. For dessert, we will be having a Belgian Chocolate Fondue accompanied by pound cake & fresh fruit. The chocolate fondue will be accompanied by a French **Pinot Noir from Les Janelles**, vintage 2007.

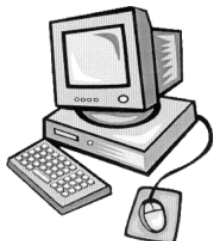
The Younger Woman's Club received 37 Grant Applications totaling approximately \$180,000!
