### Get to know Your Bylaws

This month, it's time to take closer look at the one requirement that aligns most with our mission "to serve the community and our members in ways that enhance the quality of life of each".

Article III - Membership Section 1 (A) Active:

She shall be required to secure a minimum of \$150 in Charity Campaign cash pledges. This requirement can be met in the following ways:

- Secure cash pledges equal to \$150 from friends, family, neighbors or co-workers.

- Call past donors at this year's phone bank to be held at Republic Bank on October 26th and November 16th at 6:30 PM.  
Write a personal or company check for \$150.

Remember to ask for the donations, you just may get a response of "Yes, we will because Yes We Care!"

Solicit new donors; ask your family members, boss, coworkers, friends or neighbors – you must reach the \$150 mark to be complete

Write a check for \$150 – try to make this your last resort.

Member elects, if you attend a phone bank and do not raise your \$150, you have still met your requirements. If you are unable to attend a phone bank, you have to raise your \$150 in the same ways as listed above.

I know that this is confusing, but just know that this is easier than it used to be; donations used to have to be \$35 and above to count towards your requirements.

We are changing up the Holiday party this year. We have done a Holiday Tea for many years, but it was during the day on a Friday and not always easy to attend. This year Elizabeth Bowling and Kristen Miller are planning a Midnight in the Garden of Good and Evil Party – think a Savannah Christmas. It will be the evening of December 16th. It's time to think about Charities Group. Remember if you are in your first 2 years of membership, you need to serve on this committee.
